# COSHH Assessment

## Thermo-Plastic - Line Marking

### Job Description

Hot applied thermo-plastic (liquid) lines on tarmac and concrete.

### Hazard

Hot materials; fumes from thermo-plastic material; contact with skin.

### Health Risk

Burns; skin irritation; inhalation.

### Control Measures To Be Implemented

Skin contact with hot material should be avoided. Contaminated skin should be washed thoroughly. Inhalation of fumes should be avoided as far as possible. Contaminated clothing and rags should not be re-used. Protective clothing should be worn: - long sleeved clothing, full-length trousers, impervious boots & gloves. The carriage of thermo-plastic materials is not subject to Hazardous Substance Conveyance Regulations.

### Notes

The recipient of this information must be aware that all operatives have adequate training or skills in the use of the above hazardous substances and are provided with all necessary protective and preventative measures. The regulated exposure duration's to carry out the specific jobs must be adhered to.
